Revista de Análisis is an academic publication of the Central Bank of Bolivia (BCB), edited twice a year, which includes research papers that contribute to economic debate with scientific rigor.

Call for Papers

Under the regulations of the Editorial Board (EB) approved by the BCB Board Resolution 29/2009 of March 26th, 2009, we invite professionals and researchers to submit research papers in the area of macroeconomics and economic policies. The contents of the volume will be focused on economic analysis topics, with emphasis in research papers related to the **Plural Economy in the current Bolivian model**.

The papers received will be evaluated by the EB with the participation of anonymous reviewers (or referees) thus ensuring the impartiality and seriousness of the process. Selected papers will be published in Volume 15 of *Revista de Análisis*. It is recommended to take into account the following aspects:

1. Papers can be addressed from both a theoretical and empirical perspective.
2. Papers can be written in Spanish or English.
3. Papers should be sent in Word or PDF format, to the following email address: revistadeanalisis@bcb.gob.bo. The message to be sent must include personal data of (the) Author(s) (name, phone number, address and e-

mail). Authors will receive an e-mail which will confirm receipt of the work.

4. The contents of articles must be original.
5. The first page of the document should include the following information: title of the article, name(s) of (the) author(s), abstract no longer than 150 words, up to five keywords, and no more than five JEL classification codes.

It is important to consider that only the first page must contain information regarding the name of (the) author(s) and institutional affiliation, if applicable.

6. The extension of the papers should not exceed 40 pages in Arial font 11 or similar, and 1,5 line spacing (including annexes).
7. Papers must be elaborated by following the instructions of the *Guía de Estilo de la Revista de Análisis del BCB*, available on the **Publicaciones/Revista de Análisis** link of the institutional website www.bcb.gob.bo. This requirement is an essential prerequisite for the final publication of the document.
8. The deadline for papers submission is June 6th, 2011.

It is also announced that contents of Volume 16, which will be published in the first half of 2012, will be focused on the topic "**Strengthening the use of domestic currency: the Bolivianization**". The corresponding Call for papers will be published soon.
