**Revista de Análisis** is a semiannual academic publication edited by the Central Bank of Bolivia (CBB), which includes research papers that contribute to the economic debate with scientific rigor.

**Call for Papers**

According to the CBB Editorial Board (EB) regulation, approved by the Board of Directors Resolution N° 29/2009 on March 26th, 2009, we invite professionals and researchers to submit research papers in the area of macroeconomic and economic policies. The Volume will focus on economic analysis issues, emphasizing the topic “**Challenges for Economic Growth in Bolivia and Latin America**”.

In order to ensure the impartiality and seriousness of this call, the received papers will be evaluated anonymously by the EB with the participation of prominent professionals. Selected papers will be published in the Volume 19 of the **Revista de Análisis**. It is recommended to take into account the following aspects:

1. Papers can be addressed from both a theoretical and empirical perspective.
  2. Papers can be written in Spanish or English. It is recommended that the authors submit a translation of the title, abstract, and keywords, from Spanish to English and vice versa, accordingly.
  3. Papers should be sent in a Word or PDF format to the following e-mail address: [revistadeanalisis@bcb.gob.bo](mailto:revistadeanalisis@bcb.gob.bo). The message must include personal data of the Author(s) (name, phone number, address and e-mail). Authors will receive an e-mail confirmation of receipt.
  4. The content of articles must meet the following requirements: originality, scientific rigor, contribution to economic knowledge, breadth and depth of the subject, and focus on issues of economic interest.
  5. The first page of the document should include the following information: title of the article, name(s) of the author(s), abstract no longer than 150 words, up to five keywords, and no more than five JEL classification codes.
- It is important to consider that only the first page must contain information regarding the name of the author(s) and institutional affiliation, if it is applicable.
6. The extension of the paper should not exceed 40 pages in Arial font, size 11, or similar, and 1,5 line spacing (including annexes).
  7. Papers must be written following the instructions at the [Guía de Estilo de la Revista de Análisis del CBB](#), available on the institutional website [www.bcb.gob.bo](http://www.bcb.gob.bo). This requirement is an essential prerequisite for the final publication of the document.
  8. The deadline for papers submission is May 31, 2013.

Likewise, we also announce that content of the next publication to be published during the first half of 2014, will be focused on the topic “**Industrialization: its importance in the Bolivian economy**”. The corresponding call for papers is forthcoming.
