

Assessment of key cash management issues based on the results of a survey conducted throughout the country

Abstract

Based on the results of a survey carried out on October 2018 by the Treasury Management of the Central Bank of Bolivia (CBB) this research assess different issues related to the actions and operations carried out by the CBB throughout the cash cycle. The results show that the actions of the CBB are positive and largely respond to the needs of the population in terms of availability, quality and safety of legal tender bills and coins. In order to achieve the direct benefit of population there are, however, some tasks that require to be adjusted.
